- Never give out your personal information. There are dozens of companies calling you about Medicare. Don't entertain them. There are real people who can help you make the best choices for your Medicare plan.
- The IRS will never email you for additional information.
- If you're on your computer, you get a <u>WARNING</u>, and <u>YOUR COMPUTER HAS BEEN LOCKED</u>, don't panic. Hit
  the Ctrl + Alt + Del keys. This will open Task Manager. Click End Task, and that will close your browser. DO
  NOT call the phone number they give you.

#### NOTES FROM MARILYN: April 2024

- 1. Spring is here! Please remember that the only lawn decorations that are permitted must be placed in your backyard or on your porch. No decorations are allowed in the front or side yards, or front and side flowerbeds. (Rule C, #5, #5)
- 2. No landscapers are permitted to use the yard waste dumpster. This is for residents only. If you hire someone to do work in your yard, they must take your yard waste with them. They may not put it in our dumpster. Please remember, we now have cameras at the dumpster and can see what is happening.
- 3. If you are making changes to the outside of your home (shutters, doors, windows, roof), your yard, or landscaping around your home, you must get permission from Hometown America to do so. You can email me for a form, or you can pick up a form in the Activity Room. The form must be completed and approved before you have the work done. (Rule C, # 1)
- 4. If you see a streetlight that is not working or is blinking, please report it to the office so it can get repaired.
