

Notes from Marilyn: (August 2023)

1. Yard Waste Dumpster:

- What not to put in yard waste dumpster. Plywood, lumber, stones, branches over three inches thick, or branches over five feet long.
- Please call us if you accidentally drop a bag or container in the dumpster.
- If you take shrubs or bushes out of your flower beds, put them behind the dumpster.
- If you notice someone who is not a resident using the dumpster, please let us know.
 - ** Someone is not taking the list seriously. It may not be a resident, but if it keeps up, we could lose the yard waste dumpster. Huge tree trunks were put in and Butch spent hours getting them out. He could have been doing other repairs. The person is on video, we are investigating. Fines will be issued if we find who is not following the dumpster rules. **
- 2. If your mailbox is difficult to open with your key, spray your key and the lock cylinder with WD-40. If you still are having problems, you must contact the post office in Myerstown.
- 3. Butch and I are marking sidewalks that need repaired. We may be done by the time you receive this Newsletter. If you notice a sidewalk we may have missed, that is not marked, please let us know.
- 4. If you drop a note off at the office, mailbox, or under the office doors, please make sure you put your name and phone number on it. This way I can follow up on what is being done or I can ask questions to resolve the situation.
- 5. Please be careful with your toilets, scrub sinks, and the drain in your garage. On Sunday July 16th, the sewer was clogged with a black trash bag. Luckily Butch could get here and unclog it before it caused a problem in the line leading to people's homes. Over the last year we had diapers flushed, paper towels, and various paper items that clog the line.


