




REMEMBER:


If the arm of the gate is up in the air and there is no car in front of you, you may drive thru.

The gate sensor will detect your car and the gate will reset itself after you drive thru. The arm will come down after you go thru.

If there is a car in front of you, do not drive through until the gate comes down and resets itself after they go through. If you drive through before the gate comes down after the car in front of you went through, the gate will come down and hit your car—which means you are piggy backing, and the gate arm will hit your car!




