HOW TO AVOID SCAM (<u>Skilled Con And M</u>isdirection)

Many scammers hunt for victims with calls or emails claiming to be from a government agency, a bank or even from Amazon and Xfinity. You are wise to be skeptical of anyone who demands payment out of the blue.

- Ask clarifying questions. If a scammer gets irritated when you try to slow it down, they are probably a fraud.
- You should never pay a bill with a gift card, wire transfer or Bitcoin. Any reputable organization will ask for a credit card. Check your credit cards often.

NOTES FROM MARILYN: MAY 2024

1. I have started the 4-sided inspections. I am taping your copy of the report at your front door. If you have any questions about my findings, please call the office with your questions. Please leave me a message. I will call you back after I review your questions.

- 2. If you have visitors or relatives who would like to fish at the Arbor Gate Lake, you must be with them.
- 3. If you have visitors or relatives who would like to walk around the lake or the gazebo, you must accompany them and remain with them at the lake even if you are unable to walk around with them. <u>Please inform them not to throw rocks into the lake</u>. We paid to have the rocks put around the lake. They keep the dirt from running into the lake.
- 4. REMINDER: The speed limit is 25 mph. If you must brake to go around a corner, you are going too fast. If you are driving in the middle of the road or on the wrong side to go around a corner, you are going to fast! The police have been notified of our problem with speeders. If you get a ticket, I warned you.
- 5. Soliciting is not permissible in Arbor Gate. If a contractor puts a sign in your yard to advertise, that is soliciting. We do not allow anyone to walk around and give out business cards. We do not allow anyone to go door-to-door for any reason.
- 6. REMINDER OF APPROVAL FORMS AND WHY: We ask you to fill out an Authorization form when you are getting anything done on the outside of your home. We ask for a Certificate of Insurance from the company doing the work. This is to protect you and us as the landowner. I have noticed a lot of things being done without approval forms. Approval forms do need to be done for the driveway, new roof, removing bushes, etc.



WELLNESS CHECK-IN SERVICE

We have a wonderful community here in Arbor Gate with many single people who live alone and many who are caregivers to their spouses. Do you have a person who checks in with you every day? What if you need help because you are sick or have fallen? As a caregiver, you are responsible for

your spouse. Does your spouse know how to contact someone if you need help?

Here is a way to have someone check on you every day. Towne is a company which offers a complete array of services that can be tailored to meet the unique needs of any individual. Towne offers three kinds of wellness phone check services: 1) *Well-Check Care Calls*: Live operators make daily reassurance calls to you. They provide reminders for meals, medication and appointments and also talk with you about how you are doing and what you are up to that day. If they cannot reach you, they will contact your designated contacts. 2) *Automated Care Calls*: Their system will place an automated call or a text to you at the predetermined time you have chosen. If you do not answer the call, the system will call back or try your cell phone, or both. If those calls are unsuccessful, then they will attempt to call your contacts. 3) *Monitored Check-In Calls*: This automated service allows you to pick the time of day to call in and an allowable window of time to be able to do so. If that window closes without a call from you, then their operators will attempt to reach you or your contacts.
